

# How to hook up your mobile phone with Fritz!Box

The “Call through” function in Fritz!Box can save you a lot of money especially if you make calls abroad. As you don’t need a special mobile phone or WLAN you can make calls from anywhere on the cheap, even with the simplest mobile phone.

**Preparation:** If you want to hook up your mobile with Fritz!Box you need to apply for a **Caller ID** with your fixed line telecom provider first.

**1 Step:** The best way to hook up your mobile will be if you take advantage of the integrated phonebook in Fritz!Box. (Menu: [Telephone Book](#)). Just enter the phone numbers of people you wish to call. The [Quick-dial number like \\*\\*702](#) can be used later in your mobile phone book simplifying the dialing process.

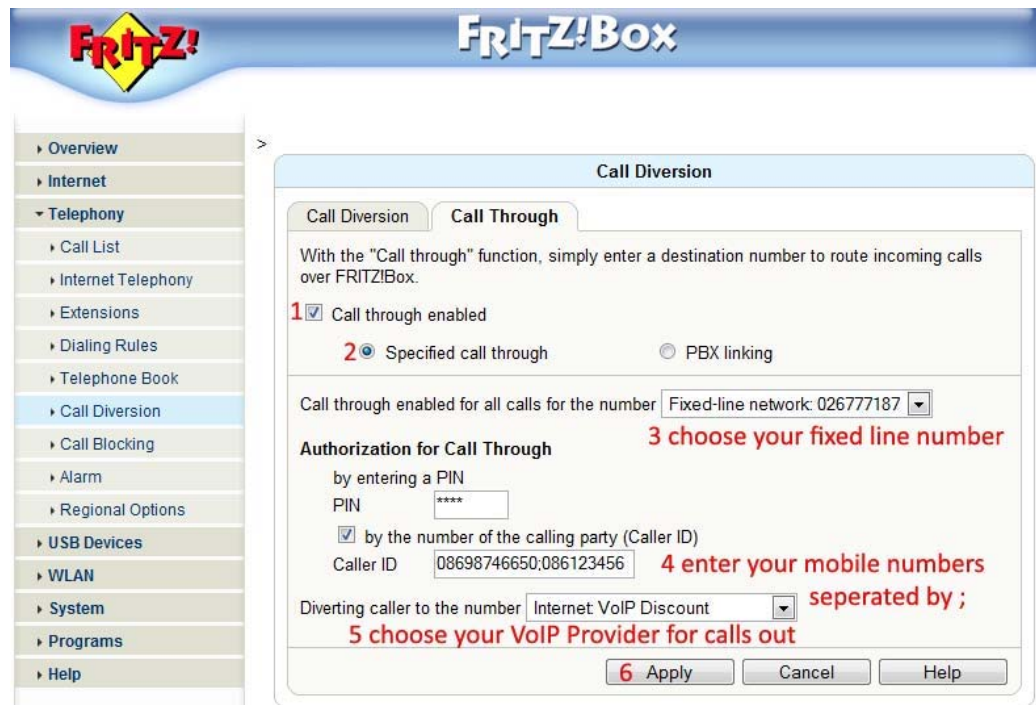

**2 Step:** Open the Menu [System/Expert Settings](#) and follow the Instructions in the screenshot.

**Follow the steps 1-4 in the picture**

**3 Step:** Go to [Telephony/Call Diversion](#). Switch to the “Call Through” folder. To allow your mobile phone to make calls via Fritz!Box you have to register your mobile phone number in Fritz!Box first. Follow the instructions in the screenshot.



**4 Step:** Pick your mobile phone, enter the phone number you want to dial as follows & save.

Explanation:	fixed line number	pause <sup>1</sup>	PIN <sup>2</sup>	0	pause <sup>1</sup>	Quick dial number	optional <sup>3</sup>	Save

<sup>1</sup>Enter a “pause”. This is done as follows depending on your brand of mobile

**NOKIA:** A ‘p’ should appear after \* has been pressed 3 times (\*\*\*) will show a ‘p’)

**ERICSSON & SAMSUNG:** A ‘p’ should appear after \* has been pressed and held.


**MOTOROLA:** A ‘?’ or ‘p’ should appear after \* or a ‘p’ should appear after # has been pressed and held.

**SIEMENS:** A ‘+’ should appear after \* has been pressed 2 times or after 0 has been pressed and held.

**PANASONIC & ALCATEL:** A ‘p’ should appear after 0 has been pressed and held.

<sup>2</sup>0000 is the standard PIN for Fritz!Box

<sup>3</sup> pressing # at the end of the number string speeds up the dialing process

From now you can use your mobile phone anywhere within your country to make cheap VoIP calls abroad. More information can be found if you press  in the Fritz!Box menu.
